HUTT STEMM STUDENT CHALLENGE

On Tuesday 28th May, 8 of our students attended the Hutt STEMM Student Challenge.

This is a quiz type event run by Hutt Science which tests students on their scientific knowledge and also includes some practical elements, for example this year they programmed a robot and built a tower from spaghetti.

Naenae Intermediate entered 2 teams, along with 14 other intermediate and full primary schools in the Hutt Valley area.

After 5 challenging rounds of questions and activities, Naenae Intermediate Blue came out 2nd overall, losing to Wellesley College Team 1 (Rutherford) by only half a point. Naenae Intermediate Yellow also did exceptionally well placing 6th equal. The final results were (from 30 teams);

1st Wellesley College Rutherford (44 points)

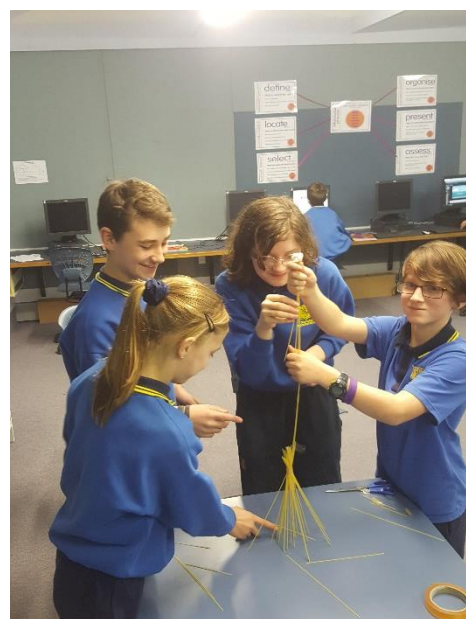
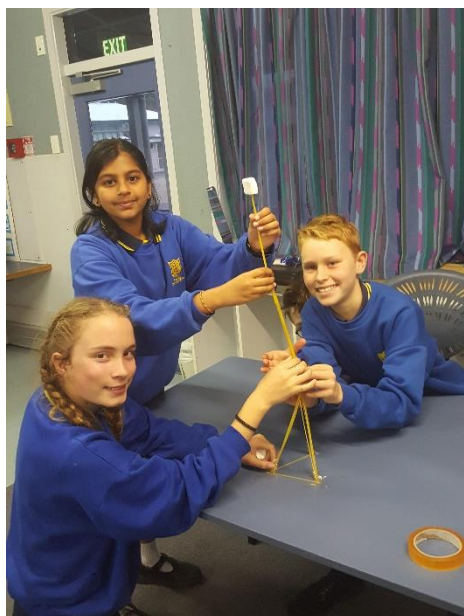
2nd Naenae Intermediate Blue (43.5 points)
